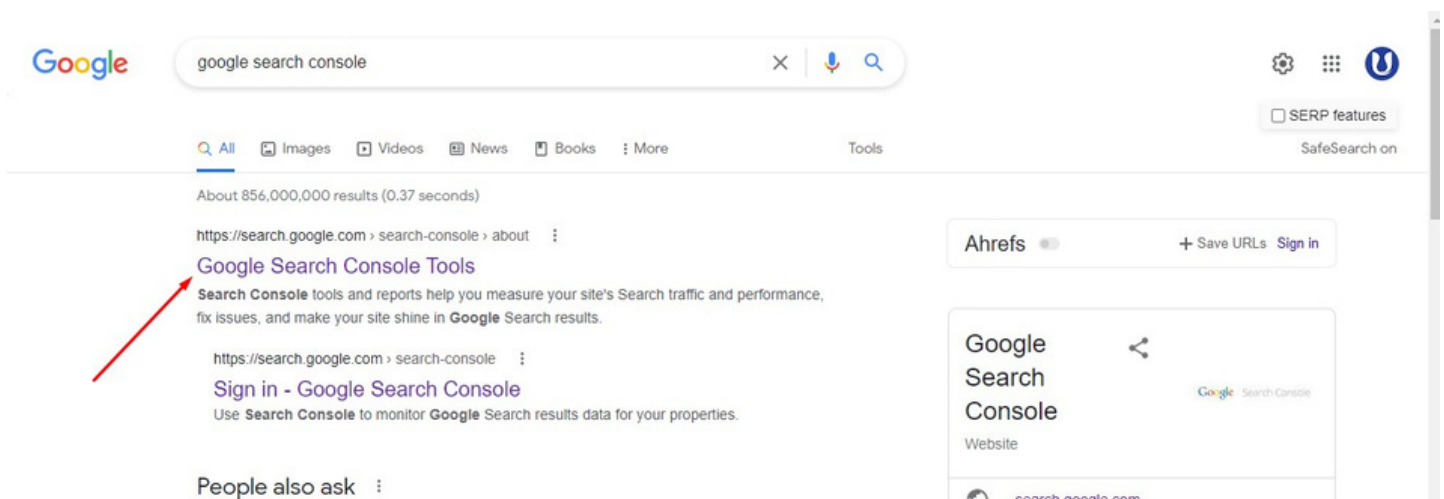

Search "Google Search Console" and continue with Google Search Console Tools

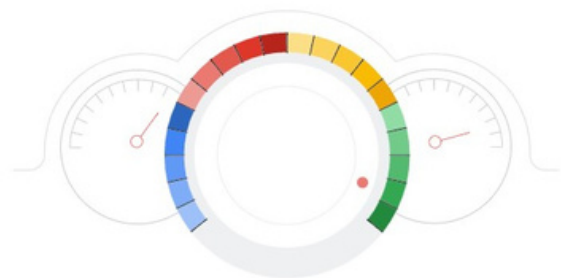


Click on "Start now"

Improve your performance on Google Search

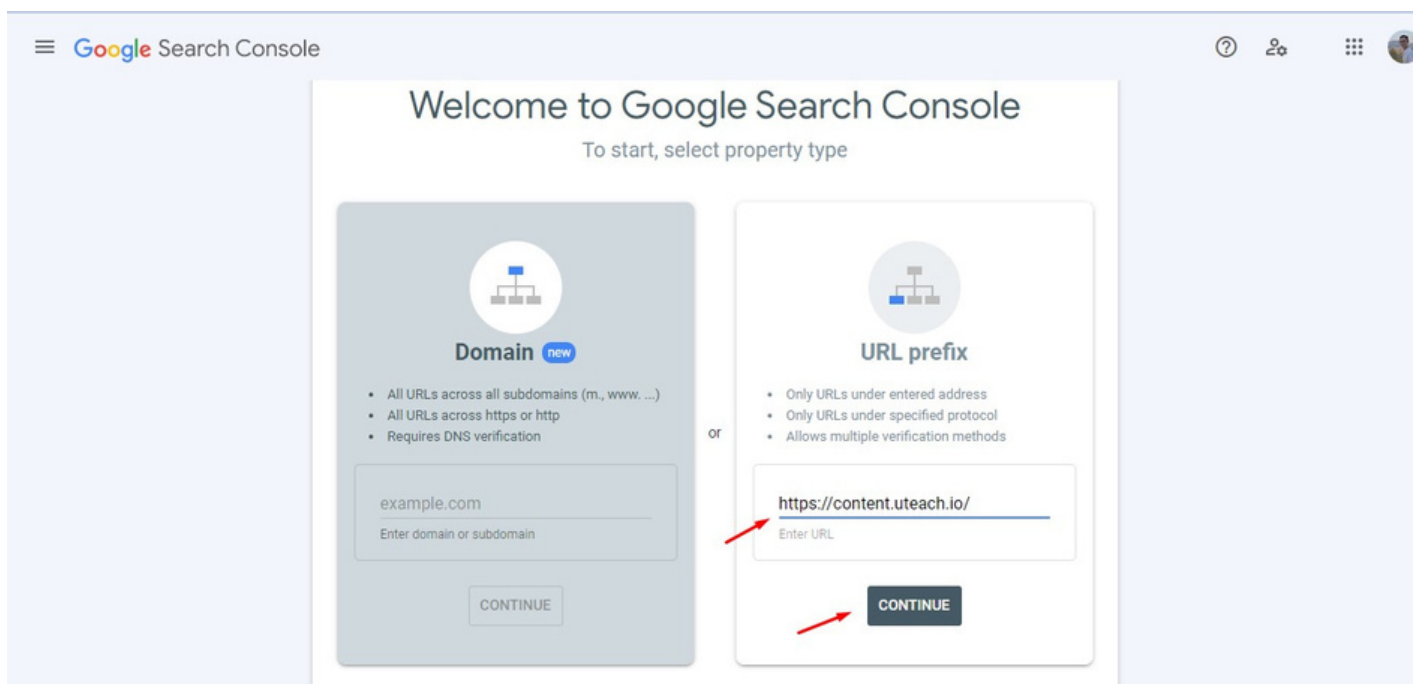

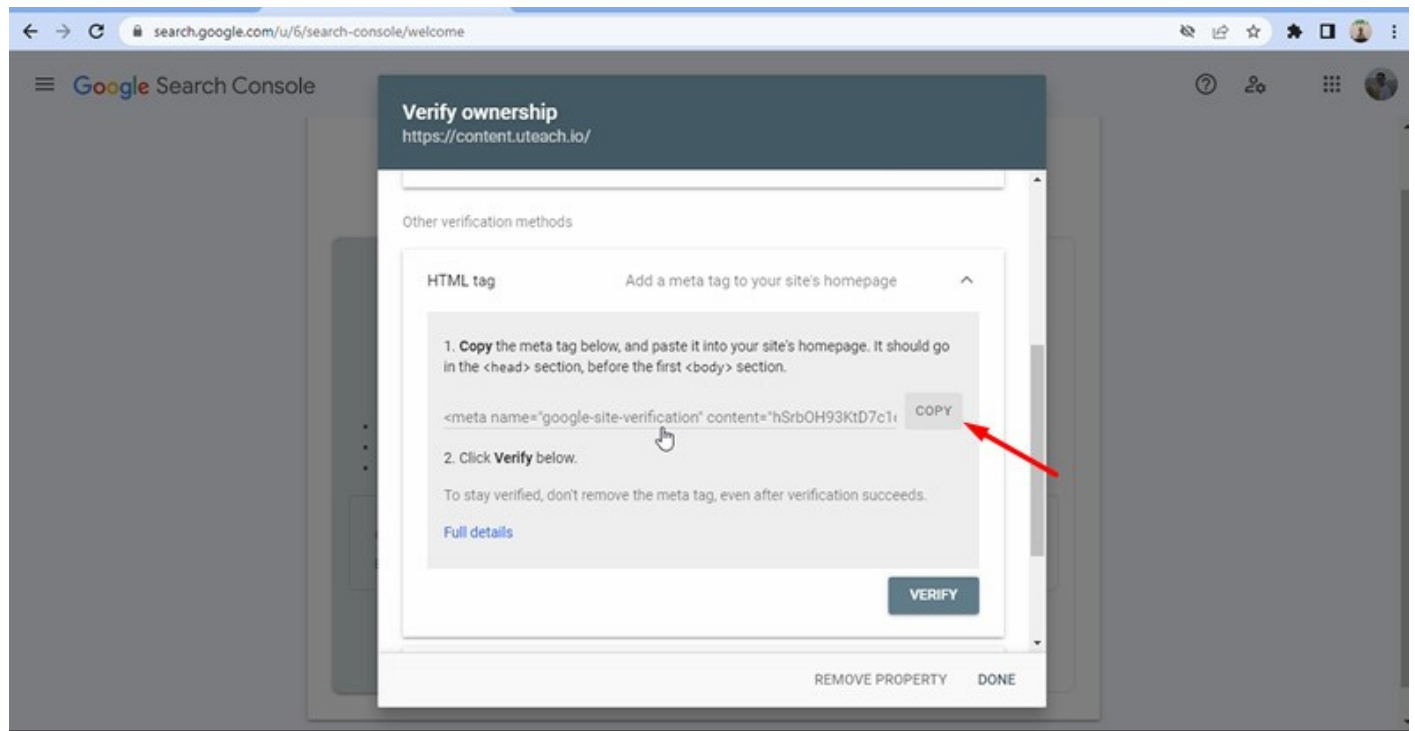


# #2 Add Your Website To Search Console Using HTML Tag

Copy the URL with https:// and paste it in the URL-prefix section. Then click on "Verify"

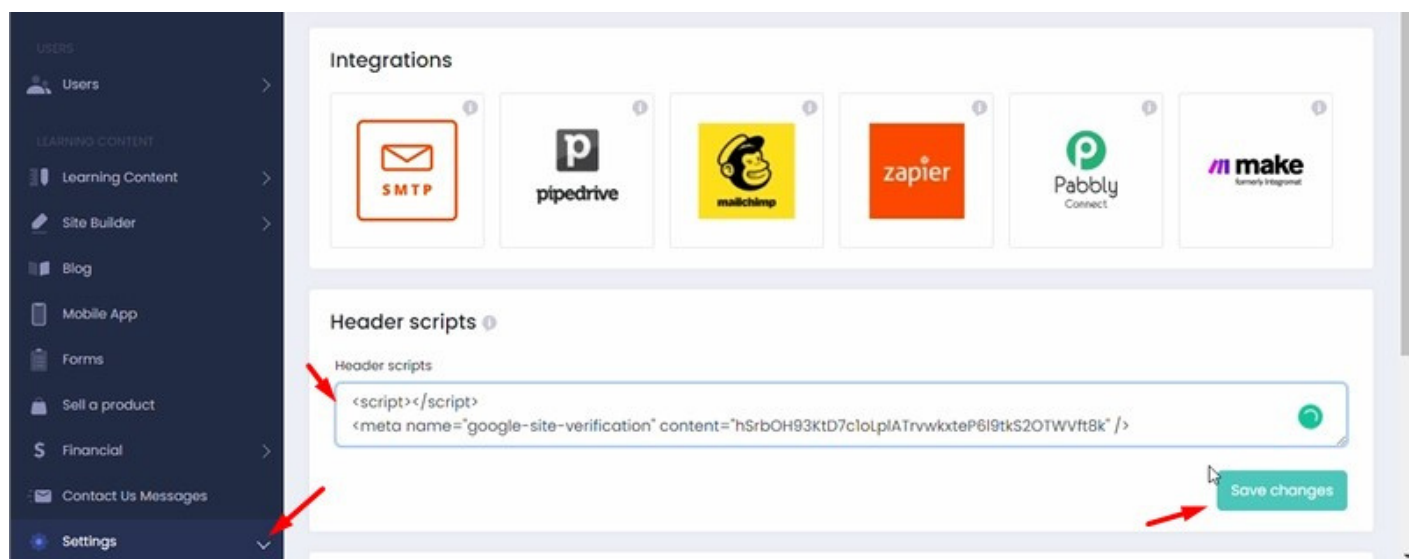


# Copy the HTML Tag

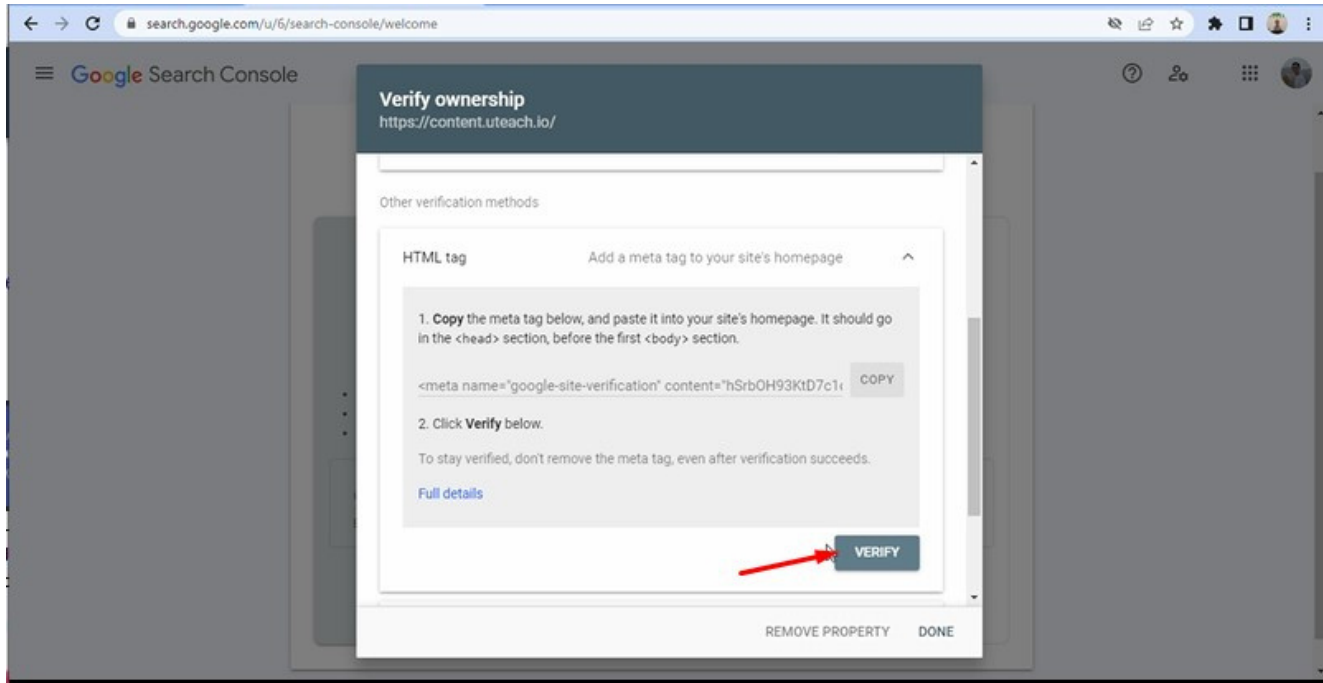


Choose Integrations from Settings.

In the Header scripts write "<script></script>" and paste the code. Click on Save changes




# Click on Verify in Search Console

# #2 Add Sitemap

Go to Sitemaps. Write "sitemap.xml/". Then click on "Submit". Your sitemap will be added. If the message be couldn't fetch, waitfor a while and restart or add again.
